

Yakka Park Camping Terms & Conditions

1. There are no refunds for site bookings due to change of mind or circumstances.
2. Please keep your site clean and tidy.
3. The Site will be patrolled by an official each day. There will be a First Aid kit available from the Site office. If it is anything more serious please dial 000 or go to the nearest hospital (Naracoorte). If you have any questions, queries or concerns please approach one of the Yakka staff or security.
4. In keeping with the all ages, drug and alcohol-free focus of the One Night Stand, Yakka Park will be a dry zone for the weekend. Licensed areas will be operating around Lucindale. In addition, no glass is permitted in campgrounds, subject to Yakka Park regulations. Inspections may be undertaken if your behaviour arouses suspicion.
5. Each person will be issued with a campground wristband on arrival. Please treat your wristbands like cash & wear them at all times – they will not be replaced if you lose them. (Please note that your wristband will not get you entry to the One Night Stand concert.)
6. Please respect your fellow campers. Poor behaviour and excessive noise will not be tolerated. If this continues to be an ongoing issue you will be required to leave. No refunds will be offered if you are asked to leave for any reasons set out in these conditions.
7. Yakka Park staff or its contractors reserve the right to refuse entry or remove any person that causes an annoyance, breaches the terms and conditions or breaks the law. Any person that breaches any of these terms and conditions can be asked to leave the campgrounds immediately and they will not be permitted back.
8. For safety reasons, no vehicles are permitted on Rent A Tent City or BYO Swag/Tent sites. The car park is located right next door to Yakka Park and a shuttle service will operate to get you and your gear to your tent/swag site.
9. No swags are permitted on Camper Trailer or Caravan sites and sleeping in cars is strongly discouraged.

Any vehicle movement on/off Camper Trailer and Caravan sites must be escorted and will be restricted to the following times:

- Thursday 3pm - 10pm
- Friday 8am - 10pm
- Saturday 7am - 3pm
- Sunday from 7am

Outside these times, the gates will be locked and no vehicle movement will be permitted.

10. You must follow all reasonable directions given by Yakka Park staff and security staff.
11. We reserve the right to amend or vary the campground configuration and capacity. We reserve the right to deny admission to the area with reasonable cause.

12. Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (clause 92) - The use of Drones, onsite and in the carpark, is strictly prohibited.
13. Emergency Evacuation of Site (Clause 42) - Muster location: The grassed areas and grass roads on site. Once assembled onto the grassed areas, the general public are to wait for further instruction over the public address system.
14. Under 18 (minors) must be accompanied by a parent or guardian aged over 25 years whilst staying at Yakka Park. Proof of age identification will be required.
15. No drugs, weapons or dangerous items are permitted. Anyone found to be in possession of, supplying or consuming illicit drugs will be reported to Police immediately. This includes weapons and illegal substances or any items which may have the potential to be used in an illegal or offensive manner.
16. NO Smoking in tents.
17. Sites are allocated as bookings are processed.
18. Please come prepared for all weather. The sites will operate regardless of weather conditions. However, if there are excessive winds (over 50 km/h) or dangerous weather conditions people must comply with any direction from Yakka Park staff or security staff to leave their camp site and seek shelter in a safe place. No refunds will be given should a booking be cancelled due to inclement weather.
19. The services provided by Yakka Park, Lucindale Lions Club Inc. will be rendered with due care and skill applicable to State legislation. The tent contractor and its staff will not be liable or responsible for any damage or loss suffered or incurred by you when you enter or are on the campgrounds.
20. You agree to indemnify the tent owners, staff and contractors against any loss or damage you may suffer arising out of your negligence or breach of these terms and conditions.
21. Footwear must be worn at all times within the campgrounds.
22. The tent owners will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or theft of a person's personal property at the campground. Patrons that leave valuable items at the campsite or in tents do so at their own risk.
23. Open fires, candles and fireworks are not permitted, however small gas barbeques will be permitted outside the tent, caravan or camper trailer subject to LPG bottles with current date compliance, subject to Yakka Park regulations. Safety checks may be conducted and unsafe items removed.
24. No animals are permitted on the site with the exception of guide dogs and Police support dogs.
